Anthony Kerhin, age 62, passed away on July 7th shortly after being diagnosed with cancer.

Born and raised in West Allis, Wisconsin, Tony graduated from the United States Military Academy West Point in 1981. He subsequently completed tours in Oklahoma, West Germany, and Virginia. He isn't known to have missed a single Army-Navy game.

After leaving the Army, Tony moved to California, where he pursued a career with Hughes Aircraft and met his wife Laura. He continued his career at Raytheon Technologies while he and Laura raised sons Joe and Charlie. He was very active in Boy Scout Troop 811, Knights of Columbus Council 9511, and the broader St. Angela Merici parish community.

Tony enthusiastically spent his retirement years playing guitar, researching electric vehicles, and spending time with friends. Tony and Laura also took advantage of their retirement to go on adventures throughout California, as well as Europe and Canada.

Tony had the gift of gab, made friends easily, and made everyone he met feel special.

Tony is preceded in death by his brother Chris and father Anthony Sr., and

leaves behind his mother Dorothy, wife Laura, sons Joe (Ellie) and Charlie, grandson Tyler, and siblings Jim, John, Kathy, Patty, and Jeannie.
