Mrs. Marie Elizabeth "Bette" Don Vito died peacefully on July 15, 2016 in Brea, CA at the age of 87.

Bette is survived by her children, Virginia of Cordova, TN, Ann of Corona, CA, Nicholas of Huntington Beach, Patrick of Marina Del Rey and Malcolm McCuaig of Havasu City, AZ. She is preceded in death by her husband, Leonard of Fullerton. Bette was born on February 22, 1929 in Brooklyn, NY to William O'Brien and Beatrice Mc Cuaig, both of NY. She graduated from St. Agnes Catholic School in Los Angeles in 1947. She married Leonard Don Vito in 1953 at St. Brigid's Catholic Church in Los Angeles.
