Dona E. Irwin, age 89, of La Habra, California passed away on 2 August 2021.

Dona was born in Pasadena, CA on 29 September 1931. She graduated from Pasadena High School, and then attended Pomona College to be near her boyfriend.

After attending college for two years, Dona married William "Bill" Irwin on April 15, 1951; they were married 68 years. Two months before Bill graduated college, their first child was born.

Dona was a member of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, where she served in many callings in all organizations. She will be best remembered for her strong support of Scouting where she often served as a Den Leader and Blazer Leader, helping the boys to do crafts, learn respect for the flag or experience the beach for the first time. She and Bill franchised a 7-Eleven store for ten years. In retirement, Dona was ever the planner and Bill was the driver/booking agent as they traveled to see the world as well as visit their grandchildren, especially for important life events.

Dona is survived by her brother, Jerry Eagleston and four of her 5 children: Deborah Holtzendorff, Michael Irwin, Richard Irwin, and Charles Irwin, as well

as 21 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren.

Dona is preceded in death by her husband, William W. Irwin and her son Randy Irwin.
