



## Harold V. Muller Jr.

June 12, 1938 - November 13, 2022

Harold Vincent Muller Jr. (6/12/1938 – 11/13/2022) of Fullerton, CA.

“Harry” was born in Brooklyn, NY to Harold Sr. and Madeleine Muller and graduated from St. Vincent College in Latrobe, PA. He moved to Southern California in 1960, and retired from the Information Systems staff of the Southern California Gas Co in 1992. He was pre-deceased by his loving wife Janet (2019) and brothers Raymond (2012) and Robert (2015).

Harry is survived by daughter Kristin of Juneau, AK, and son Kurt (Carol) of Bend, OR and five treasured grandchildren: Annika and Catriona in Alaska and Alex, Kayla and Julia in Oregon. He is also survived by sister-in-law Dottie Muller of Diamond Bar, CA and nieces Jill, Linda, Wendy and their families in Southern California. Harry also leaves a host of other treasured friends and family scattered throughout the country.

Harry was an active member of St. Philip Benizi Catholic Church of Fullerton for over 58 years, where he served as Eucharistic Minister to the sick and homebound, and as an Usher. Harry volunteered with Boy Scouts of America as a Scout Master / Pack Leader, with FISH of Fullerton, driving clients to medical appointments, and with a couple of greyhound rescue organizations in Southern California that rescue dogs from racing tracks south of the border. About the only thing Harry did not succeed at was fostering grey hounds, as he and Janet ended up keeping all five of their “foster” dogs.

A viewing and vigil will be held at Memory Garden Memorial Park (455 W. Central Ave, Brea, CA) on Monday, November 21 from 3:00 – 6:00 PM. Services will be held on Tuesday, November 22 at Noon in Williamsburg Chapel at Memory Garden, followed by a short graveside ceremony and interment. A traditional Memorial Service will be held at St Philip Benizi Catholic Church in the spring of 2023. Details will be provided as soon as they are finalized.
