Jose Luis Bustos Ramirez, was born in Guadalajara, Jalisco Mexico in the home of his parents Zacarías Bustos and Elisa Ramirez where he would grow up with his 9 brothers and sisters. Pepe (as he was known to those who knew him) developed the love of Fútbol at a young age and played club pretty much up until he was injured in his mid twenties.

Jose Luis also enjoyed spending time at the Family's Ranch (outside Guadalajara) with his father, he being the youngest of the Bustos boys was known to be his father's shadow. Jose Luis was married to Maria De Jesus Ramos Mejia in 1976 and started his family in the same city.

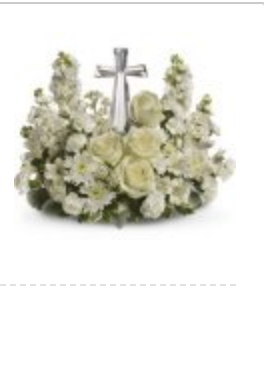
