



Joyce E. Wilson

January 1, 1933 - June 23, 2019

Joyce Evangeline Froysland Wilson, age 86, of Brea, died peacefully on June 23rd while staying at her vacation home in Oceanside. A teacher for many years, Joyce was a warm, caring person who organized family gatherings on holidays and birthdays and stayed in touch with her many friends and relatives even during 15 years of battling Parkinson's Disease.

Born in Audubon, Minnesota, on January 1, 1933, Joyce earned a Bachelor of Science degree from the state college at Moorhead, Minnesota, and taught school in Fargo, North Dakota, and Rialto, California, and for 35 years in the Anaheim City District. She spent 18 of those years as a social science teacher on closed-circuit television, researching and presenting a series of memorable lessons.

In 1977, Joyce married the love of her life, Harold Wilson. For twenty-two happy years, they traveled, square danced, attended USC football games, and enjoyed family activities, including annual trips to reunions of Harold's widespread relatives. They sponsored several of those reunions, in Brea and in Oceanside.

Joyce was a member of the California Retired Teachers Association, Republican Women of Brea, the Checkmates Square Dance Club, and Emmanuel Lutheran Church of La Habra.

Joyce is survived by her brother, Roger Froysland, her stepchildren Denise Wilson, Ken Wilson, Kurt Wilson and his wife Jackie Hyman, seven grandchildren and numerous great-grandchildren, as well as five nephews,

many cousins and their spouses.

Joyce's funeral will take place on Saturday, July 6th, at 10:30 a.m., at Emanuel Lutheran Church at 150 N. Palm Street in La Habra. 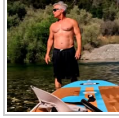
