Linda Fullerton Prescaro, age 84, died peacefully surrounded by her family on December 29, 2021 in Saint Jude Hospital after a courageous battle with pulmonary fibrosis and pneumonia.

Linda was born on October 3, 1937 in Hanover, Pennsylvania to Joe and Fanny Fullerton. Linda was raised in Hanover and attended Penn State University, where she met her husband Bob, and graduated with a double major in English and Home Economics, a notable degree of her time. After raising her five children, Linda returned to school where she earned her teaching credential and went to work as a teacher and Program Director for troubled teens, spearheading many innovative youth programs that are still in use today. Linda was happily married to Bob Prescaro, who was her partner in life for over 63 years at the time of her death.

Linda is survived by her husband, 3 of her 5 children, 12 grandchildren, 1 great grandchild and so many other extended family members.

Besides spending time with her family, which was her true love and calling in life, Linda had a passion for people. She would often give a complete stranger a compliment to brighten their day, or a few dollars to a person in need. Linda had a bright, energetic and caring personality and was known for her ability to sense when people needed her help. She touched many lives with her

generosity and passion for life.
