



Lois Marie Krein

May 22, 1928 - January 11, 2024

Lois “Sis” Marie (Holter) Krein, 95, passed away peacefully at home with her daughter and son-in-law by her side on January 11, 2024 in Anaheim, California. She was born on May 22, 1928 to Carl Oscar Holter and Anna Marie Zaun in Valley City, North Dakota. The family moved to Jamestown, North Dakota when Lois was a young child.

After graduating from Jamestown High School on May 30, 1946, she spent a few years traveling around the United States with her brother Gene Holter, performing various acts for his shows (i.e. racing ostriches, racing camels, breaking horses, riding elephants, playing donkey baseball, showing the “Lost Canyon Cattle” and Zonkey).

On March 2, 1952, Lois was united in marriage to Gottlieb “Tony” Krein at the Hitching Post in Las Vegas, Nevada. They met while Tony was doing work for Lois’ father at their family home. Tony and Lois Krein made their home in Fullerton, California, and were blessed with two daughters, Darline and Linda Krein. On November 4, 1969, Tony Krein passed away in Stanton, California.

Lois and Kermit Jorgensen started dating in June 1976 until his death on February 9, 2019, never marrying. In the spring, Kermit would go home to Flaxton, North Dakota to farm and return to Fullerton, California in the winter. They spent a lot of time in Laughlin, Nevada together but always made sure to

be home for birthdays and their granddaughters' sporting events.

Lois will be forever loved and dearly missed. She is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Linda and Harvey Vigoren, granddaughters and their husbands, Sabrina and Matthew Roberts and Melissa and Joshua Garcia, great grandchildren, Zachary, Tyler and Riley Roberts, along with nieces and nephews and their families. She was preceded in death by her husband, Tony Krein, daughter, Darline Krein, partner, Kermit Jorgensen, parents, Carl and Anna Holter, brothers and their wives, Gene and Margaret (Reeck) Holter and Kenny and Susie (Romero) Holter.
