Michael Barry Condiff, 72, of Brea, passed away on Wednesday, March 26, 2014.

He was Born in Salt Lake City, Utah, on August 14, 1941, to Margaret and Barry Condiff. After moving to Norwalk, California in 1958, he graduated from Santa Fe High School in 1959. After marrying Jacqueline, his high school sweetheart on August 11, 1961, he attended Cal State University Long Beach where he received a Bachelor's degree in education. After teaching in South Whittier at Carmella Junior High School for seventeen years, he then attended the University of La Verne where he earned a master's degree in school Administration.
