It is with heavy hearts and sadness that we announce the peaceful passing of Prakash Jashbhai Patel. Prakashbhai passed away on February 3, 2025, surrounded by his family, in Los Angeles, California.

Prakashbhai was born in Sojat, India on September 3, 1943. In his early 20s, he came to the United States to achieve his Master's in Civil and Structural Engineering at West Virginia University. Post his education, he settled in Pittsburgh, PA and eventually started his family.
